# Instructions for head strap mounting and adjustment


The head strap passes through the rings on both sides and the top respectively, and then adjust to proper fit.

- 2. Tap on the touchpad with your finger.






Slide left or right to turn a page

## Cursor positioning instruction


The device is capable of sensing the movements of the user's head. It is also capable of positioning to the corresponding part of the screen in accordance with head movements.



#### Selection

- 2. Tap on the touchpad (on the right side of the device).



#### 5. Controller connection

- •Make sure the VR headset bluetooth is enabled
- Please press and hold the return key and the home button until the VR headset successfully identifies the controller. When the controller is connected successfully, the white indicator light will go out
- Controller connection failed, the white indicator light flashes (once a second)
- If the white indicator light is off but the controller is not connected successfully, please confirm whether it is interfered by the signal from other nearby devices. After removing signal interference, try connecting again

## Safety information

- -Prevent physical impact to the device from collision or drops.
- —Use only manufacturer-approved chargers and accessories with the device.

# To avoid injury and prevent damage to the device, please adhere to the following safety precautions

- —Do not place or store device in hot or cold locations. The recommended usage and storage environment temperature should be between 0°C and 30°C.
- Charging the device at ambient temperatures below 0 degrees Celsius or above 30 degrees Celsius may cause damage
- —When the device is not in use, store it in a cool, dry place. Do not expose the lens to direct sunlight or strong light sources to prevent screen burns.
- —Keep the device dry. Do not use the device outdoors in damp weather or rain.
- —To prevent hearing impairment, do not use earphones or headphones at high volume for extended period of time.
- —Not recommended for use by children under 13 years of age. Children under 13 and adults over 65 years old need proper guidance to limit duration and ensure rest time.
